For adjusting your headset in the future

- Your bike's headset was already properly adjusted at the factory -

Your are not likely to need more adjustment for a long while. These instructions are for the future after many many miles of riding.

Tools for adjustment

Top cap

Long bolt

Aluminum tube

Star nut is already inside steer



Stage 1

5mm Allen wrench with long bolt through top cap

Aluminum tube fits over steer after removing handlebar stem and push button

Make sure to engage threads on long bolt into star nut already inside steer tube



Stage 2

2nd Hand tighten to manufacturers headset pre-load specifications after you......

1st Loosen the clamp just above the upper headset cup that the aluminum tube is resting on



Stage 3

Make sure to re-tighten the clamp. Then remove the top cap, long bolt and aluminum tube

Button

Re-install push button before reinstalling your stem. Ready to ride!
